Keli Lane continues to assert that she did not kill her daughter Tegan: she has said so from the outset.

She was convicted by a jury after a 19 week trial, which followed a protracted police investigation. The charge was laid on advice from this Office, after careful consideration over an extended period.

The jury was given careful directions by the trial Judge, including that a finding of guilt required them to be satisfied beyond reasonable doubt. They were so directed many times. Their verdict must be respected.
